WMSE ON-LINE

...The Way In.....



WMSE On-Line is a new free service provided by WMSE and Dr. Circuits Laboratory BBS to enable our listeners to access information about WMSE, alternative music, and local events as well as converse with DJ's and other listeners.

To access WMSE On-Line you need a computer equipped with a modem and a communications software package (i.e. Windows Terminal, ProComm, Smart Comm, White Knight, etc.).

Here's what you do:

1. Set your configuration parameters to 8 databits, no parity, 1stop bit. Most communications programs are set up this way by default.
2. Use your communications program to dial 966-3685. This is a local call for most of Southeastern Wisconsin.
3. After you see the Doctor Circuits Laboratory screen, enter your first name, last name, and "n" to set up a new user account (follow the prompts).

4. To exit, type "G" for goodbye.

Once you're on-line, you can select the following from the main menu:

"B" for bulletins (WMSE schedule, new user information, Top 35, etc.)

"M" for message section (WMSE On-Line is #3, feel free to leave a message.

"F" for the files section (many files that can be downloaded)

Feel free to poke around, you can't break anything. Have fun!!! We want to hear from you!!!
