Gentlemen:

Several students at the Milwaukee School of Engineering are attempting to form a Radio Broadcasters Club and start a Current Carrier Station. This station would serve about 800 students in two adjacent dormitories at the Milwaukee School of Engineering.

We have found 1200 KHZ to be clear in this area. The two closest adjacent channel local stations are WISN on 1130 KHZ and WEMP on 1250 KHZ.

The Administration of the Milwaukee School of Engineering has several questions they would like answered before they will permit us to build the Current Carrier Station. They are:

1. What procedure is necessary to start a current carrier station?
2. Do we have to file a station plan, like a Commercial AM broadcast station, before we can start to build and operate our current carrier station?
3. Do we need a permit before we can start to operate a current carrier station?
4. Can we use call letters? If so, can we use WSOE?
5. What checks of the station's performance are required besides field strength readings?
6. Should we register the field strength and harmonic radiation checks with your office?

Any assistance you can give us will be greatly appreciated by our Club and the Administration of the Milwaukee School of Engineering.
